

Market Day 2009 Season Vendor Information

Market day is a casual monthly market for art, vintage, found items, homemade and handmade goods. Artists are encouraged to look beyond what they traditionally retail and bring a fun and inexpensive mix of items. Thinkk arts festival meets garage sale.

Summer and fall dates overlap with the nearby and very popular Downtown Farmer's Market. Market Day will have the organized marketing support of Market Street Media Foundry, RockIowa.com and the vending artists.

Booth space is very affordable at \$20 each month. There are no commissions - you keep whatever you make! It is an indoor location in a cool, funky 120 year-old warehouse building just south of Court Avenue in Des Moines' East Village.

Dates: LAST SATURDAY OF EVERY MONTH - May 30th, June 27th, July 25th, August 29th, September 26th
Rummage/Garage Sale - October 30th-31st
Black Friday Sale - November 27th

Sale Hours: 8a - 1p

Location: Market Street Media Foundry, 118 SE 4th Street, Des Moines, IA 50309 (3 blocks south of the East Village)

Prices: June - November dates are **\$20/vendor per month**
Vending is free for members of MSMF.

To Apply: Fill out the vendor application and return to Cat by the Sunday before the Market Day date in which you would like to sell. Vendors are only required to apply once per season, **but must indicate and pay vending fee for each date at least one week before the sale date.**

Vendor Requirements:

- Vendors are expected to bring their own tables. If you cannot, **they are available to rent for \$15 a week, and we must know by the Thursday before the date.**
- Applications/intent to participate and fees must be received by the Saturday before the Market Day date.
- **Fees are non-refundable.**

- A no-call no-show will remove the vendor from future Market Day dates in 2009.
- Vendors are required to arrive at 7 AM to set up booths and must have their booth cleared and cleaned by 2 PM.
- Vendors are responsible for the transportation, set up, and sales of their own goods INCLUDING sales transactions and the delivery of goods.
- Each booth is to contain original, handmade or vintage items. Mass-produced items are not acceptable.
- Vendors are required to collect the appropriate sales tax. All sales tax is the responsibility of the vendor.
- Obviously, the sale of illegal goods, contraband or other questionable items is prohibited. Vendors are responsible for acquiring any type of special sales license if their goods require it-- food, alcohol, etc.
- Vendors may share a table ONLY if the work within is fully collaborative. Market Street Media Foundry Members may share booths without meeting this requirement.
